Start in the Knowledge Bowl to learn the Rules of the Sky. Move on to a real FPV (first person view) drone simulation to get the look and feel of actually flying drones with the FPV headset. One you've mastered the simulators, try your hand at flying real drones with the help of the U.S. Drone Team. Attendees ready for the next step can attempt programming a drone to do a specific task in the Autonomous Pit. Last, but not least, hone your drone flying skills in an enclosed area to get the feel of a real drone flying competition.

There's something for students of all ages on our technology playground, but access to the entire program will be geared toward 10-16 year old enthusiasts.
